4) Nikau cut some harakeke leaves for his Kuia. Manaia gave him 6 more. Now he has 27 harakeke leaves. How many harakeke leaves did Nikau start with?
5) Mele and her Nana collected 27 shells on the beach during the first week of the school holiday, and 25 more in the second week. How many shells did they find altogether?
6) Calvin picked 35 kina at the beach. How many more kina does he need to have 50 altogether?
7) Seini is making frangipani flowers to sell at the market. She has made 54 flowers. How many more flowers does she need to have 96 flowers altogether?
8) Hemi was cleaning his toy box and found 79 Lego pieces. His Koro said there were 50 more under the couch. How many Lego pieces are there altogether?

4) Ari picked 42 strawberries at the Strawberry farm. He gave 21 of them to his little brother when he got home. How many strawberries did Ari have left for himself?
5) Charlie was practising basketball outside. He decided he wanted to make 70 shots at goal before he came inside. If he had already made 49 shots, how many more shots at goal did he need to make before he could come inside?
6) Jude was playing with his Lego. The instructions tell him he needs 68 Lego bricks to make up the Bat-mobile. He can only count 59. How many Lego bricks are missing?
7) Lily was collecting Weetbix rugby cards. She gave 15 of her cards to her friend Daisy and now has 28 left. How many cards did she have to start with?
8) Tama had 18 marbles. His cousin Pip had 32 marbles. How many more marbles does Pip have than Tama?
