

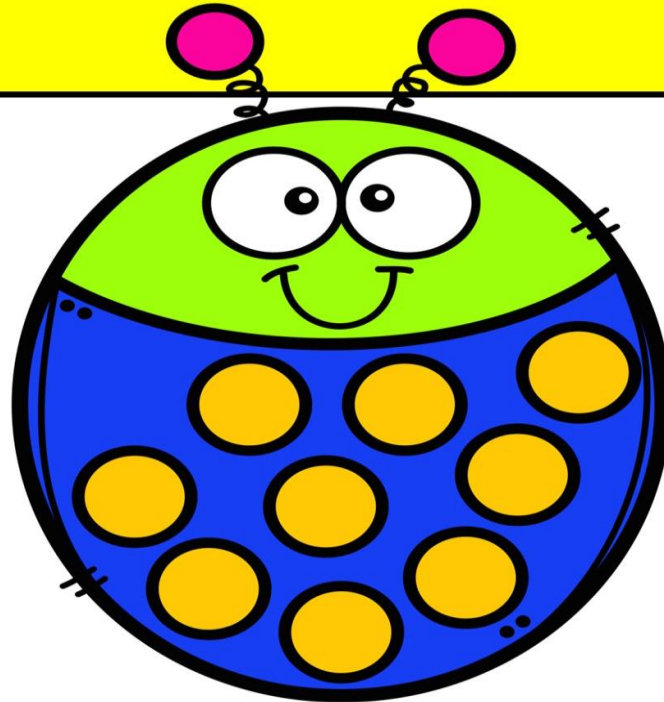


Maths Problem Solving

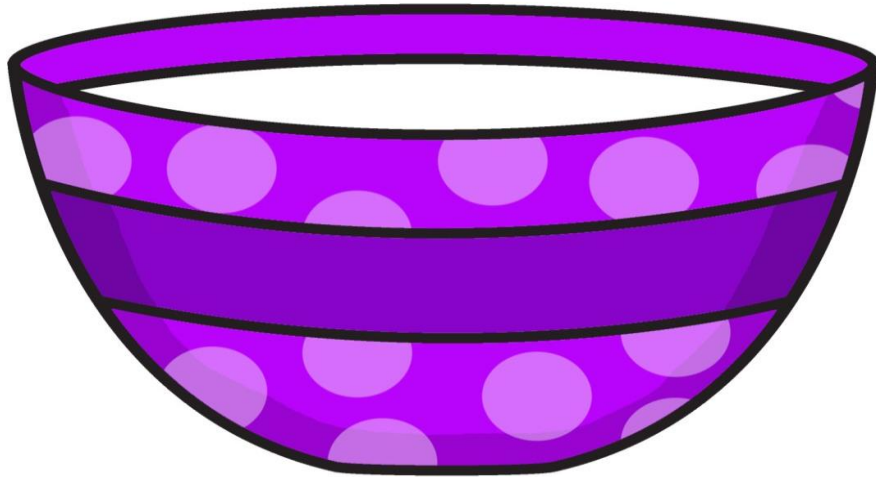
These questions are made to have lots of different answers. See the creative ways your child can solve these questions.
