The children sat all day with their eyes glued to the television screen.

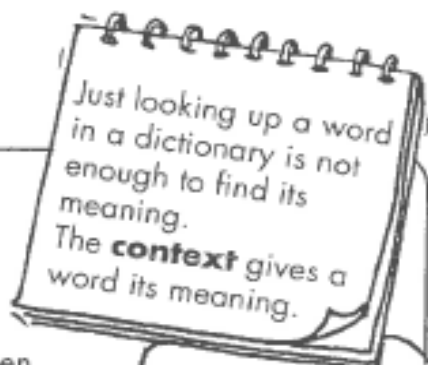
The men in the cradle were painting the side of the Empire State Building.

I worry about Hannah: she is always looking for kicks.

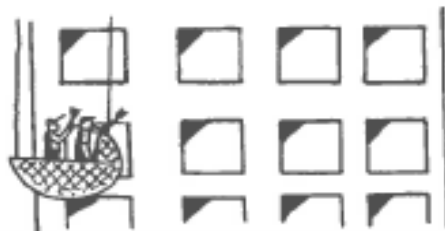
